The Belfast Met opened its latest intake of applications on the 14th August 2024 at 2pm. By 2.15pm all available assessment slots were gone as the demand for applications was much higher than the colleges current capacity.

The Belfast Met has already secured close to 1450 re-enrolments for ESOL students to continue their studies during this upcoming academic year (24-25) even before opening extra 250 places for new students on the 14th August.

If you didn't manage to secure an assessment and enrolment registration with the Belfast Met, you can consider alternative options at near by colleges such as Lisburn, Bangor (SERC) or Newtownabbey (NRC).
